Boat Texas Course (8-hour class)

The Texas Park & Wildlife Dept. (TPWD) requires this course for anyone born on or after September 1, 1993 who wishes to operate most boats on the public waterways of Texas.

(Exceptions to this TPWD rule are Paddle crafts, Vessels with a motor of less than 15 HP, & Sailboats shorter than 14 feet)

This beginner boating class will give you the knowledge needed to obtain a boat license or safety certification in many states.

Many boat insurance companies will offer discounts on boating insurance to boaters who successfully complete this course

This course provides basic safety information for people who use paddlecraft, including canoes, kayaks, and stand-up boards. It does not include water time or teach how to paddle.

There are three major points:

□ The need to have and wear a proper life jacket,

□ The need to be prepared and have proper safety equipment, and

□ The need for general awareness about all aspects of paddling safety, including situational awareness and the need to practice skills.
